INFORMATION:

The applicant has made an application for a curb cut pursuant to Section 7-1A6A of the Emmett City Code which states the following:

A. Permit Requirements: It shall be unlawful for any person to lay, place or construct any crossing over curbing in place in the City by means of cutting or removing such curb or otherwise without first filing with the Superintendent of Public Works an application for a permit and a permit being granted to do so. Upon receiving such application, the Superintendent of Public Works or his designee shall view the location or cause the same to be viewed, and shall grant or deny such permit in whole or in part, after consideration of the public interests involved. A permit given by the Superintendent of Public Works shall expire sixty (60) days after it is issued. All inspections shall be through the City of Emmett Public Works Department. A City of Emmett Right-of-Way permit shall be required for all curb cuts according to the 2006 City of Emmett Standards for Public Works Construction, Chapter 7, Project Inspection/Construction.

All work authorized by this section shall be in conformance with the Idaho Standards for Public Works Construction.

7-1A-6D.
