The applicant and/or representative will meet with the Building Official, Zoning Administrator, and Public Works Director, if applicable. The more detailed information you provide in advance, the more information you will receive at the pre-development meeting.

Scheduling

After the questionnaire has been received and accepted by staff, the applicant will be contacted within three business days to schedule a pre-development meeting with the assigned staff member(s).
